^{**} The certificate "High Ropes Course Safety Instructor Assistant" will be granted after a successful completion of the 3,5 days basic module. The certificate "High Ropes Course Safety Instructor" will be available to all those participants who have successfully completed the 5-days basic/rescue module and after successfully completing a 4 weeks trial period.

Requirements

During your time with us you will be surrounded by people on a regular basis, find yourself in stressful situations and be given a fair amount of autonomy within your activities. A class B driver's license is also needed if you are involved in the logistics roles. We look for applicants that are. 21 years or older by the time the program starts. While rewarding, the work is labor intensive and will occasionally push you out of your comfort zone. As such, we believe you should demonstrate the majority of the following traits.

- Good communication & organization skills
- Advanced Social skills
- Solid grasp of English (willingness to improve though immersion)
- Tolerance & understanding for other cultures
- Open-mindedness
- o Confidence

- o High degree of independence
- Adaptability
- o Positive attitude

Further Information

- Accommodation provided throughout the 6-month diploma program (basic accommodation: camping caravan). During the first three months you will be placed in our headquarters in Walsrode. You will sleep in a camping trailer park, a short walk away from washrooms, showers, the main building and the office.
- A 75 euro / week stipend is offered during your camp placement performance weeks.
 Training weeks are not monetarily compensated; however, Camp Europe offers all training, equipment and material, plus full room & board free of charge.
- Associated costs of transfers between camp locations, accommodation and full board during placement weeks will be covered by Camp Europe e.V.
- Upon confirming a preliminary placement offer, we will charge a deposit of 500 EUR. The
 deposit partially covers the associated expenses of the intensive training program. It will be
 fully refunded upon the successful completion of the 6-month program (training + 20-week
 placement).
